## WHAT WE DO

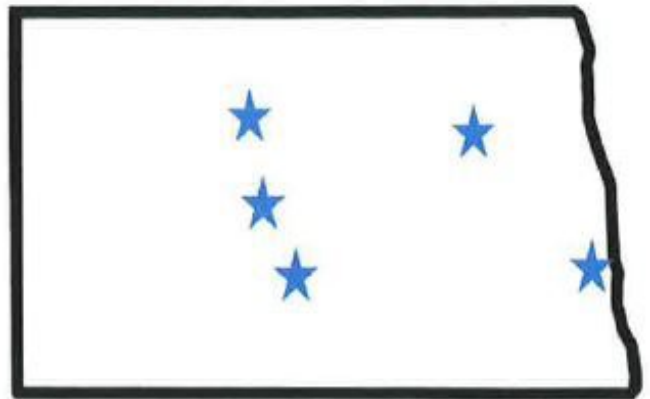
Assist and empower families as they explore the impact of hearing loss. Education in the areas of language (spoken/visual) and/or speech development as well as auditory development. Services may also include:

- Family education workshops and activities
- Support during transition from early program services to school age services.
