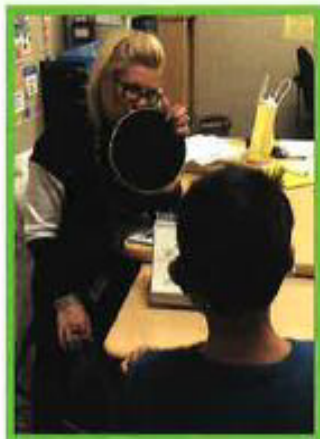
## WHO WE ARE
