

# **NDSD/RCDHH Model School Improvement Plan**

November 2016

## Model School Goals

1. Teachers identify indicators of student learning and growth to measure development of the whole child.
  - a. Objective 1. All curriculum will be based on the state standards. The standards will be prioritized for the most important 10-12 standards that will be taught to proficiency.
  - b. Objective 2. Each class will have a yearly scope and sequence that will be assist teachers with weekly lesson plans.
  - c. Objective 3. Teachers will be given common planning time when possible to develop curriculum and review standards.
  - d. Objective 4. Teachers will use data to make instructional decisions for students in weekly PLC meetings.
2. Students will achieve to the best of their ability a full repertoire of linguistic and communication competencies in use at their disposal in interactions with both deaf and hearing people.
  - a. Objective 1. Students will increase their vocabulary with new words presented weekly and reinforced in all classrooms through sign and oral expression.
  - b. Objective 2. Students will increase written and expressive communication in using phrases and sentences involving many different language structures. (following language curriculum)
  - c. Objective 3. Students will develop auditory skills progressing through the stages of auditory development detection, discrimination, identification/recognition and comprehension. (following SPICE curriculum)
  - d. Objective 4. Students will become familiar with interpreters in classrooms, large settings and electronically (IPads).
3. The Model School will be used as a training site for teachers, interpreters, nurses and others throughout the year.
  - a. Objective 1. There is an open invitation to the colleges in the state to bring students to observe and interact with the students at NDSD/RCDHH.
  - b. Objective 2. The interpreter classes at LRSC and MSU will bring students to the school as a training site for interpreting experience.
  - c. Objective 3. Teachers, parents, and others will be invited to observe the classes and other school activities.
