Communication Philosophy

ALL methods of communication, appropriate to the needs of the individual camper are used by the camp staff to ensure understanding.

These methods include: speech, writing and sign language.

The Camp's staff

Camp staff includes dedicated and enthusiastic adults, including those who are deaf and hard of hearing, who are experienced with camping. Camp involves generally one counselor for every three to five campers and is overseen by a camp director.

Triangle YMCA Camp is located at 1251 47th Avenue NW, Garrison, ND 58540 (West of Garrison).

"Camp was [my child's] first real experience meeting other kids who have hearing loss. The leaders at the camp were wonderful and truly care about the kids attending camp. It was a great experience for [my child] to be surrounded by different methods of communication. I would recommend camp to anyone who has a child with hearing loss. Camp offers our children a place to be together with other children who understand some of the challenges and successes they deal with. Friendships and memories will be made that the kids will talk about for years to come."
